

The October 5, 2016 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was held at the municipal building and called to order by Chairman Tim Hansen at 7:00 PM.

Tim Hansen, Larry Sterner, Matt Bollinger, Steve McKonly, Colin Cash and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were James Holley, Lynn & Vickie Snyder, Kevin Amoss, Paul Hilbert, Victoria Harzer, Sgt. Jack Greene, Bob Clegg, Paul Hilbert and Lester Werner.

Minutes of the September meeting were approved as distributed.

Sgt. Jack Green stated he did not have the August Report with him, but would answer any questions.

Trick-Or-Treat will be held on Monday October 31, 2016 from 6 – 8 PM.

Kevin Amoss presented the September Fire Report. The Department responded to 12 calls for the month. Kevin reported the Fire Company did a walk through of the Haunted Mill and improvements have been made.

Larry Sterner made a motion to accept the bid from Iron Ridge Valley Farm for \$3,999.50, Matt Bollinger seconded and Tim Hansen concurred.

Vickie and Lynn Snyder were seeking assistance on the alley for the homes in Porters owned by their son Shane Snyder. Tim Hansen stated the hold up is a absentee land owner, who does not live in the Township, and we want people to do what is right with correcting their septic issues in Porters. Tim would like Larry Sterner to contact Mr. Frock concerning this and explain to him this is an improvement, if this does not work, Steve McKonly will write him a letter.

Bob Clegg, of Hoff Road, stated he has his 29 acre property for sale and the realtor suggested to subdivide the property to see if it would sale. He was seeking advice from the Board. There is not a lot of road frontage and the driveway would be co-owned by the 2 parcels. There has been percs done on the property. Tim explained that this could not be done according to the Sub Division

and Land Development Ordinance. This land can only be subdivided into 1 or 2 acre plots, which is to preserve farmland in the Township, according to the sliding scale. Mr. Clegg thanked the Board for their time.

A EMS report from Thomasville was presented.

Paul Hilbert presented a list of items concerning the park area. The Board discussed new locks for the building, water only for outside use and update the language on the park rules, especially concerning dogs running loose.

Norma Markle presented the Planning Commission report for August.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Officers report. There was \$681.00 revenue for the month.

Colin Cash reviewed the Engineers Report.

Steve McKonly asked if the letter for zoning change was signed by the Fuhrman's, he was told it was not.

Tim Hansen made a motion to appoint Reg Baugher as the Alternate SEO, Matt Bollinger seconded and Larry Sterner concurred.

Matt Bollinger stated the 2017 Police Budget has been presented and there is a minimal increase of 2.2%.
