The October 3, 2007 Board of Supervisors meeting was held at the Heidelberg Township Muncipal Building and called to order at 7:30 PM by Chairman Harry Rodgers.

Members present were Harry Rodgers, Larry Sterner, Tim Hansen, Steve McKonly, John Leen and Norma Markle.

Others present were Chief Gregory Bean, Lucas Parkes, Bruce Jones, Rachel Dill, Scott Barnhart, Donna Haar, Roberta Greene, Peg Moulton and Scott Rabenstine.

Minutes of the September meetings were approved as distributed.

Chief Bean reviewed the August Police Report. The Department responded to 50 calls within the Township for the month. A speeding complaint was filed by a resident who lives along Smith Station Road and the Department set up a speed check and it found that in a 48 hour period the average speed was 43 MPH with over 4,300 vehicles timed. The Chief asked the Board for permission to use the building for "Building Clearing Training" from 2-5 PM on October 11th and 18th. The Board granted this request. Chief Bean also stated that Southwestern Regional Police will be holding an Open House at their Department October 13th from 10 AM - 4 PM.

Bruce Jones reported that 2 Eagle Scout projects have been completed one of which was installing a kitchen in the pavillion and the other planted 50 evergreens around the park. Bruce is checking with Mike Hartman concerning constructing a walking trail for next year.

Roberta Greene, from Guthrie - Hanover Library, introduced herself and thanked the Board for their past support and hopes that future support continues. Ms. Greene stated that 1,053 township residents have used the library.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission Report.

Rachel Dill, from Loss-Stair, Inc., presented a 2 lot subdivision plan for Ben Noll along Orefield Road. The existing driveway easment exits onto the neighboring property. The 1 acre lot to remain with existing resident and the other 47 acre lot to remain agricultural. The Board would like to see the driveway moved to the existing property. The Board granted a 90 day extension.

Scott Barnhart, from Hanover Land Services, responded to a letter dated 9/27/05 from Steve McKonly, stating that the Haar plan was rejected for failure to comply with conditionally approval due a time lapse. Mr. Barnhart feels that all aspects of this plan have been met and is asking the Board to reconsider this letter. Harry Rodgers stated that the plan was conditionally approved at the September meeting, pending approval by the Planning Commission, the plan was never presented to the Planning Commission and therefore the 90 day extension expired. Harry stated that there are two options, Option 1 would be to start over or Option 2 the Board may consider an extension. After a lengthy discussion, Tim Hansen made a motion to give a 45 day extension for all matters to be completed, including signatures by the Planning Commission and payment of the Recreation Fee. Larry Sterner seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred. Donna Haar thanked the Board for their consideration.

Scott Rabenstine read the Fire Report. The Department responded to 28 calls in September. Scott also stated that Department has applied for a grant through Rep. Bev Mackereth's for a generator.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Officers report. There was \$244.00 revenue for the month.

John Leen reviewed the Engineer's report. John stated that there will be a

meeting on High Rock Road concerning the curbing that was installed for the Alwine subdivision.

The Board granted a 90 day extension for the Lakepointe proposed plan along Route 116, for Bruce Ruhlman.

Steve McKonly stated he reviewed the PA Dog Law and the owner needs to have control of the dog at all times and if the dog is not on their property it needs to be on a leash. For future problems with dogs in the park it is suggested the police department is contacted.

Larry Sterner stated the truck bed has been completed and  ${\sf H\&H}$  will be completing the road work.

Larry Sterner made a motion to adopt *RESOLUTION 07-11* to the National Incident Managment System (NIMS). Tim Hansen seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

The York County Convention of Second Class Townships will be held November 8, 2007 in York. Tim Hansen made a motion to authorize anyone eligable to attend to do so. Larry Sterner seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

A letter was received from York County Preservation of Farm Lands stating that the Bradley Herr farm, off of Gitts Run Road, has been preserved, this consists of 101+ acres. Harry stated this is the first farmed preserved in the Township.

Trick-or-Treat will be held October 31, 2007 from 6-8 PM.

Scott Rabenstine stated that 20 fire extinguishers will be given away for those who need them and will be delivered and installed free of charge.

A Budget Workshop will be held October 24, 2007 at 7:30 PM.

Norma Markle read the Treasure Report.
