

The October 7, 2009 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was held at the municipal building and called to order at 7:30 PM by Chairman Harry Rodgers.

Harry Rodgers, Larry Sterner, Tim Hansen, Steve McKonly, Lucas Parkes, Jay Little and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Bruce Jones, Roger Bollinger, Sgt. Jack Green, Peg Moulton and Brian Bankert.

Minutes of the September meeting were approved as distributed.

Sgt. Green reviewed the August Police Report. There were 92 calls in the township for the month.

Bruce Jones stated that some work will be done on the pavillion and consession stand to preserve for fall and winter, with the remaining funds out of the 2009 budget.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission report.

Tim Hansen made a motion to adopt **RESOLUTION 09-09** for the Mearl Boyer module, Larry Sterner seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

Brian Bankert read the Fire Report. The department responded to 23 calls in September.

Jay Little read the Zoning Officers report. There was \$ 6,098.00 revenue for the month.

Lucas Parkes reviewed the Engineers Report. YCPC recommended lowering speed limits and posting stop signs in various areas of the township, Lucas will get with Steve to get an Ordinance prepared to get these changes implemented.

Lucas stated the church plan was approved last month but still waiting for Penn DOT permits. The Mearl Boyer plan was discussed. Lucas reported that he and Larry checked the curbing and storm inlets for the Alwine plan along High Rock Road and the Ruhlman plan along Packinghouse Road and the work was satisfactory. Larry Sterner made a motion to release the security deposits of the Alwine and Ruhlman jobs, Tim Hansen seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

Tim Hansen stated the rewrite of the Zoning Ordinance is still in progress.

A Budget Workssession will be held October 19, 2009 at 7:30 PM.

Trick-or-Treat will be Saturday October 31, 2009 from 7 - 9 PM.

The York County Convention will be November 8, 2009.

Hemler Animal Control is requesting the Return-To-Owner fee be increased from \$ 25.00 to \$ 50.00 in 2010. Larry Sterner made a motion to increase this fee, Tim Hansen seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

The Board asked Steve if the Storm Water Management Plan Ordinance could be changed by resolution, Steve feels it needs to be amended.

Steve will be filing the lein against the Anthony Wallen for the road improvements made along Cannery Road.
