

The October 1, 2014 meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Heidelberg Township was held at the municipal building and called to order by Chairman Tim Hansen.

Members present were Tim Hansen, Larry Sterner, Steve McKonly, John Leen and Norma Markle.

Others present were Clair Bankert, Robin Russo, Ed Strausbaugh, Peg Moulton, Scott Rabenstine and Officer Nolan.

Minutes of the September meeting were approved as distributed.

Officer Nolan reviewed the August police report. The Department responded to 76 calls in the Township. Larry asked the department to keep tractor trailers off of Menges Mills Road, with the weight limit restrictions. It was asked that more enforcement also be present on Jacobs Mill Road.

Scott Rabenstine reviewed the September Fire Report. The Department responded to 14 calls for the month.

Clair Bankert requested that at least another 4 Ton of blacktop be placed on Sycamore Drive.

Robin Russo, stated that he had a wildlife camera placed in the park, which was removed per Matt's request. He was told this could not be placed 30 days prior to hunting season started. Mr. Russo apologized for doing this and thanked the Board for the purchase of this land and for the privilege of hunting there.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission Report.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Officers Report. There was \$1,630.00 revenue for the month.

Norma stated that Jay Little, Sr. has passed September 24, 2014, at age 59. She stated he was a pleasure to work with and will be very missed.

John Leen reviewed the Engineers report. Discussed the Hartman/Cecil plan and the curbing plan for the Puckett property on High Rock Road N. John stated he would be interested in the police enforcement records for Jacobs Mill Road.

Larry Sterner stated that they have finished blacktopping Menges Mills and Packinghouse Roads.

Tim Hansen stated that Jay Little was an excellent Zoning Officer and will be greatly missed.
