The October 4, 2000 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:30 PM at the Heidelberg Township Municipal Building, by Chairman Harry Rodgers.

Harry Rodgers, Guy Brown, Paul Hilbert, LaVerne Becker, Steve McKonly, Dale Myers and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Michael Zittle, Dean Warner, Pam Worley, Pat Carey, Robert Finke and Nesta Becker.

Minutes of the September meeting were approved as distributed.

Dr. Zittle commented on the recent renumbering in the Township and questioned the name of his street, he was told it is Laure Woods Lane. A correct sign will be ordered. Dr. Zittle asked the Board about installing a sign at the entrance to Laurel Woods at the expense of the home owners. He will get a design and present it to the Board, they explained it can not be installed on the Township right-of-way.

Pat Carey commented on the recent work done in Laurel Woods, she stated that the grates were poorly done and that there is a build up of stones in this area along the curb.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission report.

Pam Worley presented the Final Plan for Adaline Delaney. This right-of-way would access parcel 2 as well as parcel 1. The Board feels that this would require a driveway permit from the state. Harry Rodgers made a motion to conditionally approve this plan subject to PA DOT approval of driveway permit, the Township will hold these plans till this is received. Paul Hilbert seconded, Guy Brown concurred.

Dean Warner read the Fire Report. There were 20 calls for the month. Dean stated that Open House will be held Oct. 8, 2000 from 1 - 4 PM at the Porters Fire Company.

Guy Brown stated that he is working on updating the Ordinance for controlled burning within the Township.

Dale Myers read the Police Report. The Department traveled 2,215 miles and had 367 hours of service for the month.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Officers Report. There was \$3,384.00 revenue for the month.

LaVerne Becker stated that he received response from 7 home owners along Gitts Run Road who are interested in hooking up to Penn Township's sewer. LaVere will forward a letter to Penn Township for this request.

Harry Rodgers made a motion to pass **RESOLUTION 00-02** accepting recommendation of the Joint Police Study to create a Regional Police Force. Guy Brown seconded, Paul Hilbert concurred. This board can spend up to \$ 2,500.00 for the study. Heidelberg Township will be representated by Guy Brown, Norma Markle and citizen to be named at the November meeting.

Harry Rodgers made a motion to adopt **ORDINANCE 00-01** authorizing a uniform street light assessment within the Township. Guy Brown seconded, Paul Hilbert concurred.

Steve McKonly reviewed a letter from George Hubley regarding land boundries within the Township. Steve will correspond and state to leave as is.

Star Steve stated also that some revisions need to be made to the Sub-Division Ordinance. The Board okayed to do so.

Guy Brown stated that the paving has been completed in the Township. Shutt Road drainage problems will need to be addressed. Gitts Run Road, prelimary plan, can be completed once the detours are complete.

Steve stated that the Porter's area alley situation is not resolved. Steve suggested obtaining an abstract to be sure all is in line, at the cost of approximately \$ 125/\$150.00 per property. The Board stated this should be done.

Budget workshop will be held October 16, 2000 at 7:30 PM. Property 2000 at 7:30 PM.

The County Convention will be held November 2, 2000.
