

**ORDINANCE 2025-02**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HEIDELBERG, YORK  
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 88-2, AN  
ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS ON CERTAIN  
STREETS, AS AMENDED**

**WHEREAS**, on September 7, 1988, the Board of Supervisors of Heidelberg Township, York County, Pennsylvania, enacted Ordinance No. 88-2, An Ordinance Establishing Maximum Speed Limits on Certain Streets; and

**WHEREAS**, on January 4, 1999, the Board of Supervisors of Heidelberg Township, York County, Pennsylvania, enacted an un-numbered Ordinance establishing Maximum Speed Limits on Certain Streets, supplementing Ordinance No. 88-2 by adding additional streets; and

**WHEREAS**, on January 4, 2010, the Board of Supervisors of Heidelberg Township, York County, Pennsylvania, enacted Ordinance No. 10-1 establishing Speed Limits on Yingling Drive and North High Rock Road; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors wish to amend Ordinance No. 88-2, as amended and supplemented, with reference to the maximum speed limit on Pamadeva Road, changing the maximum speed limit of 35 miles per hour to a maximum speed limit of 25 miles per hour; and

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Board of Supervisors of Heidelberg Township, York County, Pennsylvania, enacts and ordains as follows:

**SECTION 1:** A maximum speed limit of 25 miles per hour is hereby established on the entire length of Pamadeva Road, and it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle on any part of said road at a higher rate of speed than 25 miles per hour.

**SECTION 2:** The speed limit set forth and established in Section 1 hereof has been determined in accordance with 75 Pa.C.S.A. §§ 3363 and 6109(10).

**SECTION 3: Repealer.** The provisions of Ordinance No. 88-2, as amended and supplemented, which are inconsistent with this Ordinance are expressly repealed to the extent of any inconsistency.

**SECTION 4: Savings Clause.** In all other respects, Ordinance No. 88-2, as amended and supplemented, shall remain as enacted and ordained.

**SECTION 5: Severability.** The provisions of this Ordinance are severable, and if any of its sections, clauses, or sentences shall be held illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional, such provision shall not affect or impair any remaining sections, clauses, or sentences of the same.

**SECTION 6: Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with law.

**IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by the Board of Supervisors of Heidelberg Township this 3 day of September, 2025 at a meeting duly and legally held at which a quorum was present.
