

ORDINANCE 2026-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HEIDELBERG, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. _____, TO RESTRICT VEHICLES OVER TWENTY-FIVE (25) FEET IN LENGTH FROM USING CANNERY ROAD

WHEREAS, on _____, the Board of Supervisors of Heidelberg Township, York County, Pennsylvania, enacted Ordinance No. _____, An Ordinance restricting access on Certain Streets; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors wish to amend Ordinance No. _____, as amended and supplemented, to restrict access to Cannery Road for vehicles over twenty-five (25) feet in length as described in LTAP Technical Assistance Report 24288, dated October 16, 2025, conducted by Brian Taylor;

WHEREAS, a copy of LTAP Technical Assistance Report 24288 is attached, labelled “Exhibit A,” and incorporated by reference into this Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Heidelberg Township, York County, Pennsylvania, enacts and ordains as follows:

SECTION 1: Access shall be restricted to vehicles over twenty-five (25) feet in length on Cannery Road in accordance with Exhibit A; provided, however, that school buses, emergency vehicles and vehicles making local deliveries or pickups are exempted from restriction imposed under this section.

NOTE: *Consider whether residents who live on Cannery Road are permitted to drive their otherwise restricted personally owned vehicles or work vehicles to and from work.*

SECTION 2: The determination to restrict access to vehicles over twenty-five (25) feet in lengths on Cannery Road has been made in accordance with 75 Pa.C.S. 4902(b).

SECTION 6: Repealer. The provisions of Ordinance No. _____, as amended and supplemented, which are inconsistent with this Ordinance are expressly repealed to the extent of any inconsistency.

SECTION 7: Savings Clause. In all other respects, Ordinance No. _____, as amended and supplemented, shall remain as enacted and ordained.

SECTION 8: Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable, and if any of its sections, clauses, or sentences shall be held illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional, such provision shall not affect or impair any remaining sections, clauses, or sentences of the same.

SECTION 9: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with

law.
