The September 5, 2007 Board of Supervisors meeting was held at the Heidelberg Township Municipal Building and called to order at 7:30 PM by Chairman Harry Rodgers.

Members present were Harry Rodgers, Larry Sterner, Tim Hansen, Steve McKonly, John Leen and Norma Markle.

Others present were Sergent Layton, Bruce Jones, Doug Stambaugh, Lucas Parkes, Paul Hilbert, Peg Moulton, Doug Wark, Scott Rabenstine, Doug Barmoy and Tom Buhl.

Minutes of the August meetings were approved as distributed.

Sergent Layton reviewed the Police Report for July, the Department responded to 75 calls within the Township.

Bruce Jones reported he is working on getting the DCNR monies released for the completion of part of the park. Also will be working on a walking trail for 2008.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission Report.

Doug Stambaugh, from Group Hanover, presented the Final Plan for Romaine Gardner. This plan was conditionally approved last month pending driveway issues were addressed and also a notation placed on the plan stating "no curbing as long as it is not being developed". A maintance and use driveway agreement was presented that showed access to the two properties along this right-of-way, but did not show anything to the former Prin farm. After obtaining this information the Board agreed to sign the plan.

Mr. Hayes, from Hanover Land Services, presented the Preliminary Plan of Laurel Summit II, for Alan Haar and Donna Haar. The plan consists of 1 existing lot and 9 new lots. After consulting with John Leen and Lucas Parkes, they stated that all items have been addressed. Tim Hansen made a motion to conditionally approve this plan upon the Planning Commission signing. Larry Sterner seconded and Harry Rodges concurred.

Scott Rabenstine read the Fire Report. The Department responded to 17 calls for the month.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Officers report. There was \$454.00 revenue for the month.

John Leen reviewed the Engineers Report. The park plan is ready for review with additional parking areas.

Larry Sterner made a motion to accept a 90 day extensions for the Lake Pointe Associates and Ben Noll Plans. Tim Hansen seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

Steve McKonly discussed the pull off the police department requested for performing truck inspections.

Larry Sterner reported the new bed for the one dump truck is being manufactured.

Harry Rodgers made a motion to hire Katelyn Sterner and Blair Myers to assist the road crew as needed. Tim Hansen seconded and Larry Sterner concurred.

A request was recieved from Jeri Jones asking the Board to declare Sunday, September 30, 2007 as "Rev. Lou Ann Jones Day" and would like a township official to present this Procolamation at this service honoring her 25th year of ordination. Larry Sterner made a grant this request, Tim Hansen seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

Larry Sterner made a motion to accept the PA DOT 2007-2008 Municipal Winter Agreement for the township to plow and maintain state roads within the township, except for Route 116 for a total of \$22,051.66. Tim Hansen seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

Larry Sterner made a motion to allow the Fire Police to assist at the Spring Grove Area Community Center's September Fest, for September 22, 2007, as requested by Mayor Aumen. Tim Hansen seconded and Harry Rodges concurred.

A letter was reviewed from York County Commissioners requesting assistance with payment for gypsy moth spraying for 2008. No action was taken.

Paul Hilbert stated a dog law should be enacted in the township. Sgt. Layton stated this is covered under the state laws and to contact the police when dogs are seen running at large. Steve will check out if something can be adopted.

Norma Markle read the Treasures Report.
