

The September 7, 2016 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was held at the municipal building and called to order by Chairman Tim Hansen at 7:00 PM.

Tim Hansen, Matt Bollinger, Steve McKonly, Adam Smith and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Matt Warner, Jane Perash, Donald Myers, Ken Myers, Scott Krug, Kevin Amoss, Laura Lash, John Kottmyer, Kelly Altland, Victoria Harzer, Sgt. Jack Greene and Scott Rabenstine.

Minutes of the August meeting were approved as distributed.

Sgt. Jack Green presented the July Police Report. The Department responded to 77 calls in the Township.

Scott Rabenstine presented the August Fire Report. The Department responded to 10 calls for the month. Scott stated the straw/hay bale fire on Degan Road caused run off into Oil Creek and fish were killed. Scott also stated that the new brush truck was in the parking lot if anyone would like to see it after the meeting.

Scott Rabenstine stated that he is disappointed with things he is hearing concerning the EMS service for the Township. This would be with Spring Grove Ambulance and their is a feeling of conflict of interest with Spring Grove and Health Stat, which took over at Thomasville and Matt Bollinger is a member of. Are the Supervisors aware of a pending problem with the EMS? After a lengthy discussion Tim Hansen suggested to avoid future problems that all parties sit down and discuss the issue that everyone is on the same page.

Donald & Ken Myers presented a sketch plan for a proposed sub division of the Krug property along Old Hanover Road. Krug proposed to keep the junk yard (40/45 acres) and the rest would be bought by the Myers'. There would need to be 150' road frontage to access the junk yard.

Jane Perash of Rosepoint Way stated that the road has been topped 3 times and all 3 areas are separating and causing some sink holes. There was some cold patch placed but it has washed away. Mrs. Perash is very concerned also with the erosion of her yard during storms. She would like someone to come out and look at the road while she is there so she can explain her concerns and feels curbing would be the answer. She was told that there was no requirement for curbing for this development. Adam will get together with Larry Sterner and set a date to meet Mrs. Perash on site.

Norma Markle presented the Planning Commission report for July.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Officers report. There was \$910.00 revenue for the month.

Adam Smith reviewed the Engineers Report. Adam presented a Resolution to opt into the York County Regional Pollutant Reduction Plan for the 2018 MS4 permit. This has a deadline of October 4, 2016 so action will be required immediately. Steve McKonly suggested to opt in. Matt Bollinger made a motion to adopt **RESOLUTION 2016-05** to "Opt-In" to the development of the York County Regional Pollutant Reduction Plan, Tim Hansen seconded.

Steve McKonly presented a letter for Mr. & Mrs. Earl Fuhrman to sign for the proposed zoning change to their property on Gitts Run Road. Steve and Adams are still checking into the bonding of the Beckett plan on High Rock Road.

Norma Markle presented the 2017 Minimum Municipal Obligation (MMO) for the Pension Plan.

The 2017 contract for Klugh Animal Control was presented and signed.

A wiffle ball tournament will be held at the park on September 17th.

Norma Markle read the Treasures Report.
