The alternate member must reside in Heidelberg Township outside of the Heidelberg Township public water service area.

- 3. The provisions of this Resolution shall be severable, and if any of its provisions shall be held unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of this resolution.
- 4. All resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent herewith are expressly repealed.
