Applicant: Robert and Kari Meeks, Early Explorers Preschool. Applicants request a Special Exception to the Heidelberg Township Zoning Ordinance Part 5, Section 5.1(B.3), Non-Residential Uses: Commercial Daycare.

ALTERNATIVELY, Applicants request a Variance from the Heidelberg Township Zoning Ordinance Section 2.2 (Definitions – Daycare, Accessory) by allowing supervision of up to ten (10) non-residents of the site per calendar day. The Ordinance limits the number to six (6) unless a variance is granted.

Location of the subject property: 6125 Gardner Road, Heidelberg Township, Pennsylvania.

- 10. Objectors and Other interested Parties may question the Applicant and Applicant's Witnesses.
- 11. Objectors and Other Interested Parties may testify regarding other relevant information for Board's consideration.
- 12. Applicant may respond to testimony and comments of Objectors and Other Interested Parties.
- 13. Board may respond to testimony and comments of Objectors and Other Interested Parties.
- 14. Applicant's closing argument (if any.)
- 15. Board deliberation and vote
 - a. If necessary, the Chairman may recess the hearing prior to the vote to have an Executive Session to receive legal advice from the Board Solicitor.
- 16. Concluding remarks.
 - a. Explanation by Board Solicitor for filing an appeal.
 - b. When the written decision may be expected.
 - c. Other miscellaneous items needing addressed.
